If the backed up data is ever compromised on the provider's servers, this is considered a breach of HIPAA Security and Privacy. The Department of Health and Human Service (HHS) is to be notified of all organizations affected by the breach (the provider's healthcare customers). HHS posts and the names of the organizations on their website and they can impose monetary fines.

FIPS 140-2 is the Federal Information Processing Standards governed by The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST).
